Brother-Hawk for DB2 LUW managed database server has the following requirements.

Memory	2 GB of RAM recommended, 1 GB minimum
Available Disk Space	1 GB recommended, 500 MB minimum <i>Note: Additional disk space may be required depending on the amount of transactions and whether statement collection is turned on. The default maximum that the collector will use is up to 18GB. This maximum can be configured by setting the event monitor parameters in the dbievm.cfg file. Please consult the User Guide for more information on these parameters.</i>
